

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

No Power To Electronics

Problem: When the battery is attached to the Round Electronics Module and the ON button is pushed, no lights come on.

Possible Causes: First check the battery wire harness, that connects to the battery, for any signs of damage such as a melted plug or broken wires. Any cart after serial # 0007350, and any Electronic Module that was returned for repair after approximately 11/2000, would have a fuse that would be located either on the back of the Electronics Module or as an inline fuse located on the Battery wire coming out of the top of the Electronics Module. If the fuse is found to be blown a spare should be found in your utility bag. If not, a replacement is available at most any Auto Parts Store. Replace the fuse and turn on the Module. If the green battery light comes on then the problem has been fixed. If the fuse blows again you will then need to determine which of the components, Motor or Steering Solenoid, is causing the fuse to blow. Pull apart the two (2) and the three (3) prong plugs that attach the Motor and the Solenoid to the Electronics Module. Install a new fuse and turn on the electronics. If the fuse blows with nothing attached you will need to return both the Electronics Module and the Transmitter to J-Tech for repair. If the fuse does not blow, shut off the Electronics, plug in the Motor (2 prong plug) and turn on the Electronics. Run the speed up and down using the Transmitter. If the fuse blows you will need to return the Motor, Electronics Module, and Transmitter to J-Tech for repair. Call Customer Service for further instructions and return information. If the fuse does not blow then unplug the Motor and plug in the Solenoid wire (3 prong plug). Make left and right turns. If the fuse blows you will need to return the Steering Solenoid, Electronics Module, and Transmitter to J-Tech for repair. The Transmitter needs to be included because after the repair is complete the Electronics are put on a cart and we run it to verify proper operation.
